Our Latest Project

SOME UPDATES ON OUR PROJECT "POSSIBLE PRACTICES FOR PROTECTING ORGANIZATIONS FROM QUEERPHOBIC ONLINE HATE"

Over the past four months, ODLAN has been working with Wisdom2Action (W2A) to conduct research on 2SLGBTQIA+ professional experiences of online hate. W2A hosted six focus groups to gain insight into this topic. Our findings from this study are being reviewed and anonymized. In June, we will be hosting roundtable discussions to get feedback from community leaders on the digital safety strategies we develop from our findings. We will be hosting a launch of our final report this summer. Thank you the Department of Canadian Heritage for making this research possible through the Digital Citizenship Contribution Program.
