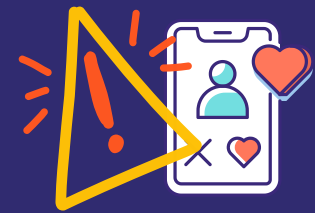
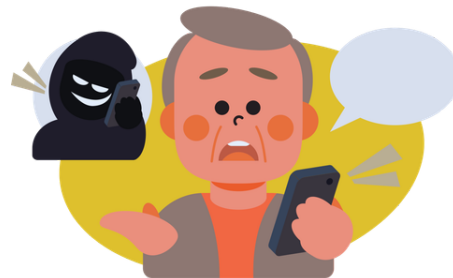


# Romance Scams: Common Lies

- Don't share your address or images that indicate your location, such as photos of your house, car, or road signs
